

# UNDERSTANDING EUROPE

Led by Wiener Volkshochschulen (AT), a consortium of educational institutions in Vienna (AT), Brussels (BE), Sofia (BG), Resita (RO), Lodz (PL), Konstanz and Hamburg (DE) compile the curriculum and handbook "Understanding Europe - A Guide to European Citizenship".

The curriculum introduces the history of the European Union and its member states, presents important European political and social institutions, and provides a basis for debate on values that are defined as European or Western values.

Didactically prepared with learning exercises for different levels of language, it will be used in adult education institutions in the context of integration courses for migrants and asylum seekers.
