### Symposium: Simulation-based research in management science

#### CALL FOR PAPERS

In recent years, the application of **simulation as a research method in management science** has gained attraction. Simulation appears to be a powerful method bridge the divide between micro-level and macro-level research in management science.

Relevant topics include, e.g., the **inclusion of micro-foundations into topics related to operative and strategic management**. In addition, simulation-based approaches are excellently suited to conduct **interdisciplinary research in terms of bridging a disciplinary divide** by incorporating theories from outside the field of management science into research problems relevant for management research and practice. Relevant topics outside the field of management science include, e.g., behavioral assumptions rooted in psychology or information science.

The investigation of **multi-level and interdisciplinary problems** leads to complex and emergent phenomena that incorporate a multitude of interrelated issues. Since manifold interacting issues lead to intractable dimensions in analytical modeling and are particularly difficult to control in empirical research, simulation offers the potential to overcome the weaknesses of these research methods.

The symposium aims at **facilitating the meeting of people who work in different fields** (e.g., Finance, Economics, Computer Science) and who employ simulation-based approaches in the context of management science. The symposium also aims at providing a **multi-disciplinary forum for presentation and discussion of recent research findings**, and is also open to contributions that are concerned with **methodological aspects of simulation-based research** in the context of management science.

#### SUBMISSION

All submissions will be subject to a standard **double-blind review process**. The best papers will be invited for

a presentation in the symposium. The symposium and all papers will be announced in the the EURAM18 program. All submissions have to respect the EURAM18 author's guidelines. The guidelines can be found [here](#).
