Preface

In accordance with § 64 (3) of the Universities Act, the admission to a Master's programme is contingent upon the successful completion of a relevant Bachelor's programme, or University of Applied Sciences Bachelor's programme, or other equivalent programme at a recognized domestic or foreign post-secondary educational institution. Where equivalence has been established in principle and only certain supplementary qualifications are required for full equivalence, the Rectorate shall be entitled to tie the determination of equivalence to examinations to be taken during the respective Master's programme.

Definition of "relevant Bachelor's programme"

The following Bachelor's programmes at the University of Klagenfurt are considered to be relevant in any case: Applied Business Administration, Business and Law, and Information Management. In the event of the successful completion of a different relevant Bachelor's programme or University of Applied Sciences Bachelor's programme in the field of economics or law, it is also possible to gain admittance to this Master's degree programme. Relevant Bachelor's programmes or University of Applied Sciences Bachelor's programmes in the field of business and economics are characterised by a minimum scope of 60 ECTS credits in the following areas: Proof of knowledge in core business subjects such as controlling, finance/accounting, taxation, marketing, production and logistics management, human resources, leadership and organisation, innovation, entrepreneurship, and public and non-profit management.
