Preface

In accordance with § 64 (3) of the Universities Act, the admission to a Master's programme is contingent upon the successful completion of a relevant Bachelor's programme, or University of Applied Sciences Bachelor's programme, or other equivalent programme at a recognized domestic or foreign post-secondary educational institution. Where equivalence has been established in principle and only certain supplementary qualifications are required for full equivalence, the Rectorate shall be entitled to tie the determination of equivalence to examinations to be taken during the respective Master's programme.

Definition of "relevant Bachelor's programme"

The Bachelor's degree programme in Information Management at the University of Klagenfurt is considered to be relevant in any case. In the event of the successful completion of a different relevant Bachelor's programme or University of Applied Sciences Bachelor's programme, it is also possible to gain admittance to this Master's degree programme. Relevant domestic or foreign Bachelor's programmes or University of Applied Sciences Bachelor's programmes are those for which students can provide evidence of the following knowledge to the extent specified:

- a. Technical knowledge in Computer Science subjects or Business Informatics subjects amounting to a minimum of 30 ECTS credits,
- b. Knowledge of Business Administration subjects amounting to at least 30 ECTS credits,
- c. Knowledge of the fundamental principles in Mathematics and Statistics amounting to the value of at least 12 ECTS credits.

Frequent transfers

Graduates from the following Bachelor's programmes or University of Applied Sciences Bachelor's programmes frequently transfer to the Master's degree programme:

BA Angewandte Informatik mit anderen Spezialisierungen als „Wirtschaftsinformatik“ (curriculum versions 2012, 2017)	University of Klagenfurt	with conditions; as well as completion of Supplementary Subject § 9 (7.3) within the scope of the Master's degree
BA Angewandte Informatik (curriculum version 2019)	University of Klagenfurt	with conditions; as well as completion of Supplementary Subject § 9 (7.3) within the scope of the Master's degree

Please note that in the event of the positive completion of elective subjects in the above-mentioned areas, it may nonetheless be possible, under certain circumstances, to gain admittance without conditions.
