Preface

In accordance with § 64 (3) of the Universities Act, the admission to a Master's programme is contingent upon the successful completion of a relevant Bachelor's programme, or University of Applied Sciences Bachelor's programme, or other equivalent programme at a recognized domestic or foreign post-secondary educational institution. Where equivalence has been established in principle and only certain supplementary qualifications are required for full equivalence, the Rectorate shall be entitled to tie the determination of equivalence to examinations to be taken during the respective Master's programme.

Definition of "relevant Bachelor's programme"

The Master's degree programme in International Management is an English language degree with a special admission procedure. The Regulation on the Admission Procedure can be accessed by following this link:

In addition to a completed Bachelor's degree, applicants must provide proof of English proficiency at level C1 of the European Framework of Reference for Languages.

Examples of relevant degree programmes include the following Bachelor's programmes at the University of Klagenfurt: Applied Business Administration or Business Administration, Business and Law, Information Management, as well as International Business and Economics. In the event of the successful completion of a different relevant Bachelor's programme or University of Applied Sciences Bachelor's programme in the field of economics or law, it is also possible to gain admittance to this Master's degree programme.

The degree programme's focus on business management and cultural issues means that knowledge covering the following fundamental areas is of particular relevance:¹

Economic Sciences, Business Administration, Economics, Business and Law, Law, Philology (Languages) and Linguistics, Communication

¹ If the Bachelor's degree does not fall within one of the above areas, the Rectorate will decide, after hearing the committee, to what extent the completed primary degree is relevant for the subject in question.

and Media Science, Information Management and Business Engineering, History or Political Science, Sociology, Psychology, Computer Science, Mathematics.

Relevant Bachelor's programmes or University of Applied Sciences Bachelor's programmes are characterised by a minimum scope of 180 ECTS credits overall; students must provide evidence of basic knowledge in Business Administration.²
