Regulation issued by the Rectorate governing the collection of fees for specific degree programmes with special admission procedures

Based on Section 63a Para. 8 of the Universities Act

- in conjunction with Section 4 Para. 2 of the Regulation governing the special admission procedure for the Master's degree programme in Artificial Intelligence and Cybersecurity at the University of Klagenfurt, university bulletin issue 5, no 29.1 dated 7 December 2022, and
- in conjunction with Section 4 Para. 2 of the Regulation governing the special admission procedure for the Master's degree programmes in Game Studies and Engineering, International Management and Media and Convergence Management at the University of Klagenfurt (GIM-VO), university bulletin issue 5, no 29.2 dated 7 December 2022, and
- in conjunction with Section 4 Para. 2 of the Regulation governing the special admission procedure for the Master's degree programme in Management, Economics, and Data Science at the University of Klagenfurt (MEDS-VO), university bulletin issue 2, no 7.3 dated 18 October 2023, and

based on Section 71b Para. 4 of the Universities Act

- in conjunction with Section 2a Para. 2 amending the Regulation governing the special admission procedure for the Bachelor's degree programme in International Business and Economics at the University of Klagenfurt, university bulletin issue 2, no 7.2 dated 18 October 2023, and

based on Section 71c Para. 1 of the Universities Act

- in conjunction with Section 3 Para. 2 of the Regulation governing the special admission procedure for the Bachelor's degree programme in Psychology at the University of Klagenfurt, university bulletin issue 8, no 36.6 dated 22 December 2021, and
- in conjunction with Section 3 Para. 2 of the Regulation governing the special admission procedure for the Master's degree programmes in Psychology at the University of Klagenfurt, university bulletin issue 8, no 36.7 dated 22 December 2021, the Rectorate hereby orders the following:

Section 1 - Fee

(1) Applicants seeking to enrol in the degree programmes listed below must pay a fee to contribute to the cost of the special admission procedure:

1. Master's degree programme in Artificial Intelligence and Cybersecurity
2. Master's degree programme in Game Studies and Engineering
3. Master's degree programme in International Management
4. Master's degree programme in Media and Convergence Management
5. Master's degree programme in Management, Economics, and Data Science
6. Bachelor's degree programme in International Business and Economics
7. Bachelor's degree programme in Psychology
8. Master's degree programme in Psychology

(2) The fee is set at € 50 (fifty euros).

Section 2 - Entry into force

(1) This regulation will enter into force on the day following its publication in the university bulletin of the University of Klagenfurt.
