Programme

- 8:45 a.m.: Graduates gather for the group photo (meeting place in front of Lecture Hall A, on the steps below the interpreter's booth).
- 9:00 a.m.: Graduates take up their positions in the formation, formal procession into the lecture hall
- 9:15 a.m.: Procession of the university officials, speeches, pledge, awarding of certificates, photos with university officials, words of thanks, musical accompaniment
- 11:00 a.m.: Estimated end of the celebration

Information

Parking: The parking spaces at the University of Klagenfurt can be used free of charge on the day of the graduation ceremony.

Champagne bar: Toast your graduation with family and friends at the end of the academic graduation ceremony. You will find a **voucher** for two glasses of sparkling wine in the order of celebration placed on your seat. It can be redeemed directly after the ceremony at the champagne bar situated in the foyer between Lecture Hall A and Lecture Hall B (level 0).

Photos: Taking private photographs during the ceremony can diminish the sense of occasion and is not permitted. Our photographer Mr. Laimböck and his team will be taking photographs of each graduate as they receive their degree certificate. Our photographer is also at your disposal after the ceremony.

Photography is permitted from the audience seating area.
